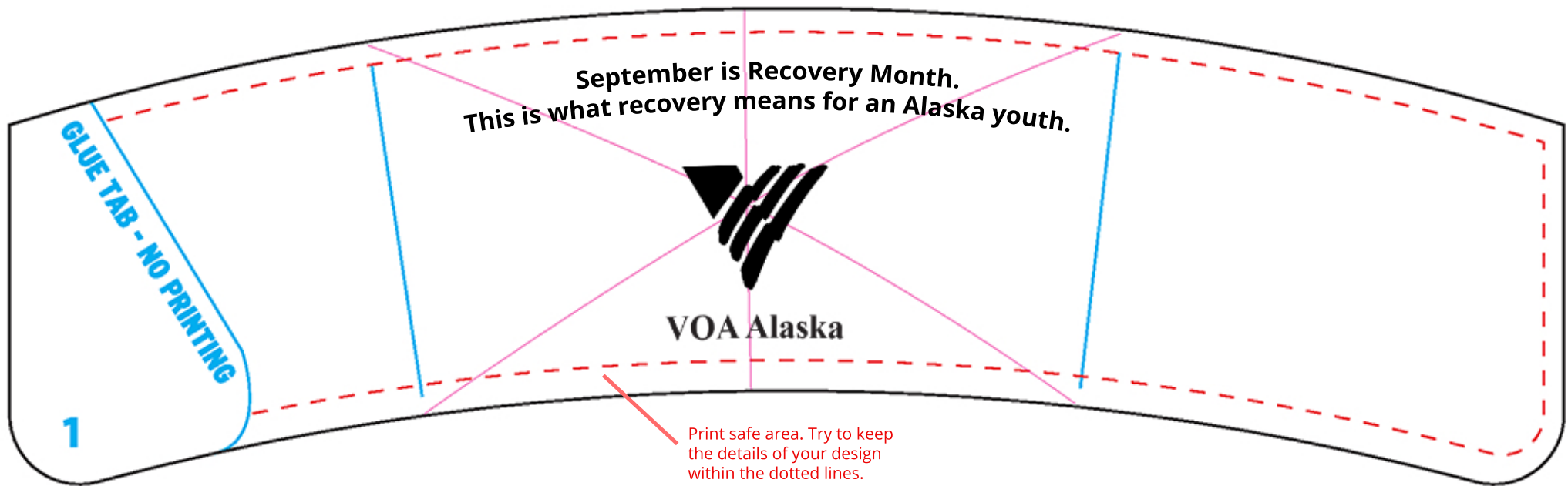


What Does Recovery Mean to You?

Design Guidelines

Don't use more than four colors in your design.

Use solid colors only, no shading or gradients.

Your design will be digitized and then printed, so avoid fine detail that may be lost in the final product.

Written text is okay, but think of each letter as a shape. Don't make it too thin or too intricate.

Care will be taken to keep the digitized design as close to the original as possible, but we reserve the right to make adjustments and alterations where necessary.
